Anarchy, Glee Erupt as SUNY Campus Burns to the Ground

NEW PALTZ — Students danced and faculty members destroyed copies of The Constitution and pictures of George Washington, as the College at New Paltz burned to the ground early Friday morning.

More than 42 buildings on the newly re-named "SUNY-No Place" campus were left in cinders after a garbage can fire near the Hasbrouck Complex, suspected to be the result of arson by ultra-Centrist revolutionaries, burned wildly out of control.

Miraculously, no one was injured and everyone had a great time. One faculty member was treated for indigestion.

Once believed to be constructed out of asbestos, the balsa wood Hasbrouck Residence Hall Complex burned to its foundations in about 13 minutes, taking most of the campus with it — with one exception being the President's Guest House, which remained standing despite being damaged from a previous fire three weeks ago.

Friday morning's was ano-alarm blaze. Area fire departments refused to respond to the scene.

Only Firefighter "Skid" Koch, who smelled the smoke from a friend's house in Kerhonksen, responded, single-handedly keeping the blaze at bay from the secret nuclear facility in the Wooster Science Building. He then cooked a 30-ounce prime rib over the embers of the Administration Building and ate it in approximately three bites.

A few students and area residents toasted marshmallows in the flames of burning buildings. Several, taken by pyromania, lit the marshmallows on fire and watched catatonically as they burned.

Members of the Wiccan Grove danced skyclad and chanted late into the night. Campus May Be Closed?

NEW PALTZ — It's possible that the SUNY New Paltz campus might be closed for a while.

Asked whether it would be, Karen Funnelin, the spokesperson, replied, "Why would it be?"

Passers-by said the reason would be that there are no more buildings on the campus.

SUNY Central (518) 443-5555 denied everything.

Orgies were reported on the Tripping Fields.

As this issue of *The Daily Screamer* went to press, students and faculty were still "in control" of the campus, running wildly here and there.

Many pranced around naked.

The anarchistic spree was a stark contrast to the usually quiet, morose state of affairs on the campus, though political science Prof. Glenn McWitt said things were not quite organized enough to be truly described as anarchistic.

Still more confustion was created when five busloads of high school students arrived for a tour of the campus later in the day.

"What the hell is going on around this place?" said Kevin Slime, a student at Wotta Thug High School in the Bronx.

"Yeah!?" said his mother, Mrs. Slime. Few campus officials would comment.

Campus Reichs Chancellor Alice President was in Cuba helping with the planning of Bay of Pigs II, a grand barbecue planned for some time before the November presidential election.

Reached at home, College spokesperson Karen Funnelin told reporters, "I have no idea what you're talking about. I'll have to look into it." She said she was planning an investigation in Mexico or the Bahamas.

"Graaaaaamlmlwaaaaahhhh!" said

Prof. Jay Doom, president of the local chapter of the United University Regressions (UUR) faculty union, as he destroyed a large portrait of President George Washington with a box cutter, and then set it aslame. He then lit copy of the Bill of Rights and used it to set the Anthropology House afire.

Doom's one-man protest was endorsed by the Local, Statewide, Nationwide, Intergalactic and Transdimensional chapters of the UUR, and he was followed by about 50 faculty members who giggled and drooled as he went on his rampage.

The faculty members, engulfed in paroxysms of revolutionary glee, clobbered each other with chunks of debris, vowing to bill the resulting hospital costs to The Empire Plan.

Prof. Maul Suckerman, Presiding Officer Over Practically Everything (POOP), screamed orders for the flames to stop, and threatened to have them arrested for trespassing. Suckerman then attempted to take the flames into custody himself but was unsuccessful. He later joined Doom's group and began slashing up copies of the Declaration of Independence. He also ate a copy of the Monroe Doctrine, after which he was hospitalized for indigestion. He was reported in unstable condition at Rockland.

The Student Association reacted quickly to the crisis and attempted to establish a lemonade stand, however the SA senate became embroiled in a 3-hour debate over whether to buy pink or regular lemonade as flames licked up the sides of the Student Union Building.

A motion to discuss the fire was discussed for 38 minutes, until the Senate table collapsed in a pile of embers.

But a motion to adjourn could not pass because quorum was not present.

"We have to do something," said SA President Toilet Net Carter.
