

Sagittarius Astrology Studio 2024-25

Good evening from New York and welcome to Astrology Studio for Sagittarius. Happy birthday. Thanks for joining me. Let's see what we can learn from your astrology.

This reading is going to focus on the Sagittarius New Moon chart. That is overnight, Friday, Thursday to Friday, December 1st is the actual time, 1:21 AM, New York time.

This is a very exciting and somewhat complex chart with a lot of information coming out of it. Now, the difference between this reading and the Awakening reading is that the Awakening is not really going to take your solar return chart into account, but rather look at a number of transits that are happening between 2025 and 2026.

Though I will be doing some of that, probably plenty of it, in this reading because they are just so exciting and so influential and they weave themselves into your story. But the immediate conditions at the time of your solar return are that particular kind of reading. Now, I know that I don't have your natal chart and therefore I haven't cast a proper solar return, an exact solar return.

But what I have learned is that I can call out, like identify and select the strongest chart from the sun's transit through a sign. And that actually often turns out to be the new moon chart, which is the conjunction of the moon and the sun.

And in this year's Sagittarius new moon, the moon and the sun are conjunct an asteroid.

Now asteroids... how influential can they be? They only weigh five pounds, and there are like 20 million of them. It's like trying to go in the supermarket and walk up to the walnut bin and try to interview one of the nuts. And expecting to get something really innovative, except for one thing.

That the asteroids all have names and mythologies and discovery histories and track records, and when you put one of those points in an exact conjunction with the moon and the sun, like to the very degree you can get an interesting result.

And we see this result confirmed by other stuff in the astrology. Now what would that be?

Urania is the asteroid of invention, inventors and inventions. And to have it exactly conjunct the moon and the sun in your solar return chart is to boldly describe a time of self reinvention. Now, one of the ways that an astrologer can tell that an interpretation has some validity is if there are other things in the chart that pretty much say the exact same thing, but without stretching, without having to use aspects with a very wide orb and so forth.

And it turns out that the planet Uranus, which is going to show up a little bit later in the year in June in a very bold way. But for now, it is still in Taurus. Is in this aspect that is associated with a kind of a power contact between all the points. It's 165 degrees. I just started using this year, I learned about it from reading a book by a brilliant old astrologer, now gone, named Al Morrison. One of the guys who brought Chiron out to the forefront and Uranus is supercharging this new moon with this self creative, self reinventive energy. And it is like a need, a drive, an impulse to reinvent yourself.

And this is difficult for a lot of people.

For as bold and adventurous as Sagittarius is, one of the defining features of Sagittarius is that you have Capricorn on the second house, meaning that you have a conservative value system. Sagittarius is often described as one of the boldest and most adventurous signs, qualities in astrology.

But to have Capricorn in the second place is to suggest a kind of a risk averse character. And I think that is pretty much going to get thrown to the four winds this year, because there is so much that is going to drive your life story forward, including and especially your relationships and whatever you think of yourself as being some kind of a creator or artist.

Those are the two major focal points where there is just going to be such an abundance of energy that you're going to have to engage with it and confront it. One way, shape or form. It's a little like the weather changing, a hurricane happening or something like this. Whatever you do, you have to do something about it.

It doesn't mean your power is going to go out likely your power is going to go on based on these transits, though I think that the right way to meet this energy is going to be creatively. And in a sense, it looks like there's going to be some kind of chaos turned loose on all of society.

And this is where the creative and self creative are at their very very best. Marshall McLuhan, my favorite philosopher of all ever, because he was just so on, and was so far ahead of his times, and he talked about this thing that we tend to ignore, which is the media environment that we live in.

McLuhan said, an artist is anyone who is good at pattern recognition.

Being an artist doesn't mean that you're good at painting necessarily, or sculpting, or welding, or whatever it might be. But rather, that you can look at something that is seemingly chaotic, and pick out the pattern. And this power coming in from Uranus, and this Urania point conjunct the moon and the sun are suggesting that there is going to be a lot to consider, a lot to look at, that you may experience changes in yourself that you had no concept were happening.

And so one of the things that's very important to do in times of change like this is to really hang loose. That does not mean be lethargic or apathetic or passive, but it means to stretch out and make sure that your muscles and your bones and your tendons are flexible because you're going to need to flex and stretch and grow as this astrology mounts, as this story develops. And I realize now that it doesn't seem like that's going to happen. That's hard to say. I'm watching the world, the geopolitics and the different developments, and then I'm completely soaked in 2025 astrology doing these 2025 readings for all 12 sites at once, that's a lot of astrology.

So I'm getting this sense of how potent the changes are going to be and the scale of what looks like a kind of a fusion of radical awakening and uprising. And these are delicate, volatile moments where there's plenty that can go wrong, but I have no doubt that the energy is going to be there.

And the most important thing that you can do besides being flexible and hanging loose is to be perceptive, to pay attention, to look at the world not so much as the drama that is being portrayed, but more like a painter lining up the point of view

that you want to paint and knowing what elements you want as a conscious choice with many things to choose from. Indeed an overwhelming number of things to choose from. We're all going to have this. This is just what's gonna happen. But what is so fortunate about Sagittarius, rising or sun, is that your chart is positioned to be able to maximize these influences in almost all cases, the least direct impact. Two of the three very biggest changes meet your chart in constructive angles rather than confrontational angles.

And we're going to get into those a little bit further in the reading when I start to go through the through the different houses in your chart one by one and explain what is going on. But first, before I do that, I want to describe a feature that is in Sagittarius and Gemini, your opposite sign.

And you may know that I work with the sign pairs as a system. So I work with the Gemini Sagittarius axis as one thing, Pisces Virgo as one thing. And in each side of that gives a different description and looks at or back from you in a certain way, but they're very closely related and they require essentially, the whole project of astrology is the integration of seeming opposites.

And here's what's going on. And, maybe you'll know what I'm talking about here. So as you know Mercury is now retrograde in your sign. That began on the 25th, and one way or the other, it affects all people with Sagittarius solar returns, even though there are a couple of days at the beginning and the end of the Sun's transit through Sagittarius where Mercury's not retrograde.

It's still very close to the station retrograde or the station direct. So the effect is at full strength pretty much for everyone. And as you may know, your ruling planet, Jupiter, is in your opposite sign in Gemini.

And this is a condition called mutual reception. When the when planets are in one another's sign of rulership.

And it, it doesn't, always happen when planets are in opposing signs. It just happens that is the situation for you now where you're ruling planet is in your relationship house, which is Gemini, and Mercury is with you in Sagittarius. And there's a few different ways to describe this, but it is pretty fair to say that it, it describes a relationship because of the first house, seventh house connection and

because of the Jupiter Mercury connection, that describes a relationship.

What kind? I'm not sure, but it's probably some sort of either a business partnership or conjugal or domestic relationship, meaning a sexual relationship or...I just so don't like the word romantic. It's ooh, I have a tablecloth and open a bottle of wine. And there's a few interesting features of this. First of all, if we just use the mutual reception, you either have a picture of a role reversal, thing one, right? Obviously, there is a mutual reception. So that could be a very closely bonded relationship because there is a reception and the reception is mutual and it's a thing where it's possible that, you may feel very close to someone.

Another possibility is that there is a role reversal of some kind. A third possibility is that there is a bond that you don't really understand, and that may be complicated, and that you don't know quite how you got into it or how to get out of it. So largely how you define the situation or you experience the situation is going to propose the type of response that you have.

My job at least is to tell you that this astrology exists, that it's there, that it is that it is present and that there are also other factors involved that elaborate on the story, that that make it clear what is what this might be about.

One of those factors is Saturn.

Saturn is the planet of structure. It is the planet associated with both authority, and inner authority. And inner authority is when you claim leadership over your life. I know that if you study HD, there's several different kinds of inner authority, and I think that their concepts are pretty beautiful.

I'm speaking just generally as if file your taxes and clean up your room, then the government doesn't have to come after you to file your taxes and your mother doesn't have to come after you to clean up your room. And if you can basically get through school without provoking too much, then you'll stay out of authority.

But usually this means discipline. Inner authority is a fancy way of saying discipline. Self discipline. And where this planet of self discipline shows up is in your fourth place of security. Now, Saturn comes into this scenario very prominently because both Jupiter retrograde and Mercury retrograde are, quite

soon, going to make squares 90 degree, very dynamic aspects to Saturn, bringing it right into the scenario.

And this says very strongly that your emotions and your sense of your personal security is the most important mediating factor. Saturn in Pisces, especially as a fourth house factor, can have a kind of a chilly feeling to it and a sense of inflexibility to it and then so therefore it is crucial that you bring your warmth and that you bring your ability to bend and flex emotionally.

But the thing with the fourth, especially with Pisces, with Saturn there, that combination of factors, fourth house, Pisces and Saturn can really talk about deep insecurity. You probably know that you present yourself to the world as considerably more confident that you are and that, one of your rules of travel is that if you act confident, people will treat you better.

And it will be easier to get what you need from them and stand up to them. But the problem that creates is, especially if you are actually feeling insecure inside, is that there can be some, tension and also the fear of being exposed. And it is fair to say that Saturn and Pisces in the fourth is not necessarily given up to being especially vulnerable and that all these points are going to be talking to each other.

The thing to beware of and to give a name to, if you have it, is some sort of feeling of a last chance. Oh my god, I've got to get it right this time or I'll never get it right again. This is the last chance to get it right. That is very likely to be completely false. It's a feeling, it's an emotion, it's probably an illusion of some kind, but it is not reflective of reality. If we want to say what reflects in reality, it's more likely to represent something like, okay, this is an important opportunity to take my life seriously and to make sure that I make an investment in growing up and that I make an investment in my maturity. And so the tradeoff here is using your insecurity as kind of a fuel for maturity.

There's a wonderful book by an old author named Alan Watts that you may find helpful, and that is called *The Wisdom of Insecurity*. Hard to believe that Alan Watts was a best selling author in his day with these books that were largely based around Eastern mysticism and Zen. By that I mean really one of the most popular spiritual authors of his day.

He wrote a whole book about how there is something helpful and something useful about insecurity because it shows up as a very important teacher. Now, part of this dynamic, and I'm not certain that this exists, but part of the dynamic may be a jealousy dynamic.

And it may be... just for the sake of discussion, just to float up an illustration and like on Sesame Street and say does this to what extent does this fit the picture? That it may describe a situation where your identity is constructed around a relationship, and if it's not constructed around a relationship, it may be built around an idea of what a relationship should be, but it looks to me like there's relationship involved because of the immediacy of these aspects are happening now with the sun in your sign while the sun makes this conjunction to your natal sun.

And what happens when one sense of identity is built around a relationship is that if that relationship either changes or shows any sign of potentially changing that it can be extremely nerve wracking. It can feel a little end of the world ish because this operating system known as your ego is so heavily invested in another person that you've essentially built your sense of who you are around that other person.

And this is a fairly natural tendency in relationships for you to have given that your relationship house is Gemini the sign of the twins. You know this concept of twin flames twin souls and all that may be something that comes very naturally to you. But however, you know, you're still a person in the world of many people with many options and any partner you have or have ever had is also a person in the world of many people and idealizations of relationships don't usually work so good.

And if it happens that you have really built yourself around someone else's personality, someone's presence, that any jolt or tribulation can shake up who you are, your sense of who you are. And so this is one reason why I consider it just personally as a, as a person, as a lover, in this role that I'm in now as a kind of a astro therapist or whatever, that it is very important to have ever deepening, grounding in who you are.

Now, this is not a total hedge against some sense of profound instability if another person starts to change, or you fear that they might change, or you're

concerned that they might experience an attraction or someone might be attracted to them. But, at least you have foundation stones to stand on.

And fortunately, there are many other factors working in your chart that describe the ways that you can deepen who you are and be more grounded in who you are, and particularly, this shows up really in two ways. This is speech and writing, that's Aquarius, that's your third place.

And your most daring creative adventures, that is Aries, you're fifth place. And the reality is that there is a very high probability that you are the person who, in your environment, whatever context, who is going through this growth experience, and you may not be able to fit yourself into a relationship, a business partnership, or a concept of what those things should be.

And then, therefore, the thing to do is, if you want to grow and be free and not get into like foot binding you have to loosen up your concept of what a relationship is, and I realize this can be very delicate. There can be a lot of a lot of letting go involved here, and it seems like a very radical chance to take.

But that said, this whole scenario is supported in a diversity of ways from a diversity of different directions, and I think that you're going to have a magic carpet to ride on. And the bottom line is that you'll be developing your self confidence and assurance that you are the right person, the person in the right incarnation at the right place and the right time and the transits come, the events come, the world turns, the world changes.

One of my favorite fortune cookies that I ever got said, "Be resolutely who you are. Be humbly who you aspire to be." One of the unusual things about 2025 is that right on the heels of very significant outer planet Pluto changing signs from Capricorn into Aquarius, which it just completed doing earlier this month, Neptune changes signs from what begins a nine month process of changing signs from Pisces into Aries.

And Saturn also is going to move pretty much at the same time as Neptune, from Pisces into Aries. So here's the challenge. Here's where you gotta solve the Chinese puzzle of be resolutely who you are, be humbly who you aspire to be, is that the, who you are right now is in a sense the product of about 13, 14 years of

Neptune in Pisces in your house of emotional security, which does not add up to emotional security.

And the be humbly who you aspire to be pertains to Aries which is really not very realistic to say about Aries, be be humbly who you aspire to be. Aries goes boldly into who it aspires to be. And Pisces is conversely rather retiring and not entirely confident of its presence in it's place and never really completely feels like it owns the day.

Whereas Aries, the whole point of Aries and for that matter, other fire signs, though, yours is a beautiful fire sign, is to take possession of the day, carpe diem. So let's take these in order and just recap Pluto in Capricorn, and then talk about it going into Aquarius and then talk briefly about what is remaining in Capricorn.

So as mentioned, one of the distinguishing factors of the sun sign Sagittarius is having Capricorn on the second place. You know that I do a whole chart reading for each individual sign. That's why I can talk for an hour and 15 minutes and still have plenty to say if I can, stop and then write the Sagittarius reading in the Awakening and cover a lot of new territory.

So one of the foundational constructions of Sagittarius, which is an expansive Jupiter ruled sign, is that in the in the house associated with your values, in your sense of self worth, you have Capricorn. And Capricorn is quite opposite of Sagittarius. It is Saturn ruled. It does not want to expand.

It wants to hold its structure. It is not really forward thinking, it rather wants to honor tradition and honor the past. And we all depend on Capricorn, like it or not. We need things of a Capricorn nature in our lives. And you happen to have your self esteem and your value structure run through Capricorn.

And this is what creates this kind of risk averse sense of existence. Even though you seem to many people like the boldest and most daring person in the world, you know how far you'll go and you'll know that there's only so far you'll go.

So what's been going on there now since 2008 is that Pluto has been working its way through Capricorn.

And this has completely upended the world, but it's also radically revised your, or come with many events that have revised your sense of who you are and your sense of where you belong and how you belong on the planet and what matters to you, the second house of values also describes priorities and Pluto loudly or quietly, quickly or slowly, one way or the other completely restructures and compels a rethinking of pretty much everything it touches. Okay, what this is to suggest is, in plain terms, is that you have had to become much, much more independent and really have questioned many of the traditions that you've taken for granted over the years. I realized, for example, if you're 30, you've had Pluto and Capricorn half your life.

If you're a 45, you've had Pluto and Capricorn for a third of your life. That's a long time. And so this not taking tradition for granted may go back quite long, quite a long way, but you may also remember a time earlier in life when you were more involved with the right thing to do. And the right thing to do had something to do with the way that it was done in the past, and there is something to be said for that. But, as my teacher Arthur Joseph Kushner once said, long gone, beloved friend, Arthur Joseph Kushner said, traditions survive by being able to change and adapt. We wonder about the Jewish phenomenon, which is deeply rooted in tradition, it's been around for 5700 years or something like that. The beautiful thing about Jewish tradition is that it is, and its leaders allow it to be flexible. It morphs to the civilization where it is happening. And then there's a certain core that is held, but still a lot of the stuff around it can transform and can morph.

And the other thing that tradition does is have a way of bending others bending others toward its will. So that, that too, those options and choosing from among them is a form of adaptability and flexibility. All right. So Pluto has radically transformed your values. The question is how? The question is in what way, what is the nature of this change and transformation? One word I used was self reliant. There's something here about going deeper in and getting to the very roots of what matters the most to you. So that's a positive thing. And then you might, notice there are things that you have just had to give up.

Things that were outmoded, that did not work, and values that you just figured out were just like not the way that you want to do things anymore, or they just simply couldn't happen. What is, now Pluto has moved on, it took about 18 months. It's very unusual, usually outer planet sign changes including ultra slow

moving Sedna, Sedna with 11,000 year orbit, only took nine months to change signs from Taurus to Gemini. Pluto with 248 year orbit took 18 months. This is a kind of a quirk of Pluto's orbit that it just went back and it grazed Capricorn for an additional 10 weeks or so, a little bit earlier in the year. So Pluto has moved on.

But what is left In Capricorn is this kind of wellspring, family legacy. And I've been calling this the Hunger Games pattern. I'm not sure how much of my other work you listen to. I have stood on my head and spun around like a breakdancer to make sure everyone's heard of this thing I'm calling the Family Hunger Game Pattern.

And this involves four ultra slow moving points, Pholus, Centaur, Quatwar Trans Neptunian, Ixion Trans Neptunian, and Cupido, imaginary pretend planet without a body. And they're all about The nature of family and the nature of influences coming from the family. And I am proposing that there is a kind of a legacy left here.

That there's something that, I mean there always is, right? We can never escape our upbringing, we can never escape our genetics, we can never escape our initial early environment, though we can outgrow them and grow beyond them, but still we take a piece of them with us all the time.

And the long term question of this group in early Capricorn, which I've put a little red bar next to on the bottom left side of the chart, I'm going to put an arrow there just so you know what it's there because I've put the opposite there's a little group in the Opposite cancer, that I put a little red bar next to also, but it's a small red bar, there's no arrow.

Is to see the different influences that have filtered through to you for what they are. And I have encouraged many times, and I know this is not a pleasant subject, to carefully study the influence of alcohol on your family. Now, there are families where this is just not a thing. It's just not a thing.

And there are families where it is a fucking thing, where it is like the biggest thing that nobody's talking about, that people refuse to talk about that is the elephant in the room and you just live with it almost like it's a permanent fixture or pretend that it does not exist but the thing is that if there is an alcohol legacy. We're

talking about the planet Pholus, this goes back really to the great grandparents generation, that it will have a traceable, documentable effect on you.

And usually that effect is to create a a sense of not wanting to be emotionally vulnerable. This is the main thing that alcohol does, is it blocks transparency, emotional expression. It makes people inaccessible, it makes them remote, and it delays the confrontation with problems that really need to be engaged and confronted.

As for Quattroire, Q U A O A R, either Kway Ar or Kwa Ar, I'm not sure which it is, I don't speak Tongva, the language this comes out of. This is a meditation on ancestral lineage all the way back. Now, remember, this is in Capricorn, which is a sign of ancestral lineage. It's the most significant sign of ancestral lineage.

And it's in your second house. And this is saying that the lineage is one of the most important things that can be inherited through a family, which is values, priorities. in attitudes. And so Quaoar goes all the way back to the origins. Our family descent, our tribe descended from the Pleiades. We are from our group is from Sicily.

That's my family story. We're from Sicily. Like I'm the only person who I think my grandfather may have gone back to Conicati, one side of the family. And I went back to on the other side of the family, Piazza Armarina. But besides that, like nobody took much of an interest in going to Sicily. Or the hometowns in Sicily.

Okay, so anyway, forget I said all that. We Italians tend to go back to the homeland. And a lot of people go back to the homeland. What's the homeland? But quaor can also be like we are the descendants of the purple people. Or we were from the tribe of men in the trees 5,000 years ago, or I personally consider myself to be a descendant of the Saurus system, Vega.

Hello, Elearoa, right? So whatever your concept of all the way back is, that's the thing that's here to work with, but it's in context of how does this filter through your great grandparents?

Next is Ixion, which is to be on the lookout for the person with no morals in the family background. And just to notate, put a pin in the map, or pin the tail on the

donkey, how did that affect you?

It could have led you to be slim shady earlier in life, or maybe no, it could have led into a reaction where you must be the most moral person you're your grandfather might have been Frito Bandito and you, and then therefore you've become a Mormon, what's the reaction against these unwholesome, unfriendly influences in the past?

Finally Cupido. That's one of those imaginary eight planets without a body. There's eight in one of these groups. This is the ninth one, but it's not related to the other eight. And that is just a point of gathering. And there's a message in here, which is that your point of gathering, your best point of gathering in a world where there's not much gathering, where people are not really getting together and they're not sitting around the table and eating is your value system.

It is what is important to you and who is important to you. But really the what is crucial here. The priorities part. The value may hold on life, on love, on money, on relationships, and to make sure that there is some. I'm not saying like form an exclusive organization of people who only believe what you believe, but there has to be some association and that is a reasonable point of collection and a point of bonding.

Okay, so what is Pluto in Aquarius?

So this is I think pretty exciting and Pluto in Aquarius. It's transited in over this 18 month period with two Centaurs. There's a Chiron like long period, kind of cometoid asteroids. And the thing that makes them special is that they, A, take a long time to go around the Sun, B, their orbits are really strange.

They're stretched out, they're elongated, they go through some signs very fast, and then the opposite side of the zodiac, they go through some signs very slowly. And, Pluto in Aquarius is, first of all, pointing to your Aquarius third house. Your Aquarius third house is that, first of all, it connotes a very high level of intelligence.

This is really the intelligence power pack of Sagittarius, is Aquarius placed on the third house. And this is a certain kind of analytical intelligence. It is a certain

ability the pattern recognition quality is very strong in Aquarius. The inventive quality is very strong in Aquarius. But so too is the ability to work with group mind.

Group mind. And this is not always a good thing. Group mind This this ability for people to work like a think tank and solve a problem together. You put a bunch of engineers in the room and you say, how do you solve that problem can also translate into group think where the group of engineers simply refuses to address the fact that the O rings are brittle when the temperature goes below 35 degrees, then the ship is going to blow up when they turn on the gas.

Okay. You want to be aware that there is group mind and group think, and Pluto is going to, let's say, light all of this up. And I think that the main effect Pluto is going to have is going to be to compel you to really think for yourself. To not want to think the way that other people think and to believe what other people think and this is a very important issue of our times a tremendous number of people were hurt in 2021 and 2022 for doing things that other people told them to do and so your independence of thought is going to be your best friend right now and that does not mean being contrarian.

Aquarius does have that contrarian factor to it but what it really is saying is that you need to take on board what people are saying and then make a complete and thorough, very deep assessment and make your own fucking decision and stick with your decision. And if somebody, your boyfriend, your husband, your wife, your brother, your parents, your boss, whoever it might be, is saying, no, what you have thought through is not acceptable to us, but you know you've thought it through and you don't want to take the risks that they're willing to take, or believe the things that they're willing to believe, that you know are complete bullshit.

It's gonna take some spine. It's gonna take some chutzpah. But Pluto in Aquarius should give you that chutzpah. There's one last point coming out of this this collaboration that I will be developing in, as, and now I'm figuring out what it's about, I'll be developing it in the remaining readings for the Awakening, which is that the centaurs are amicus, which is not very amicable.

It's a centaur of like the original Hell's Angel start the fight and the whole stadium

is fighting. And Aureus, which is about legitimate innovation and groundbreaking ideas in Business, in art, and in activism. Some of the great tech moguls, early tech moguls, have a prominent Aureus in their chart, but so too does Nelson Mandela.

in any group situation. If someone is disruptive, notice who that disruptive person is. And the disruptive person is likely to pitch themselves in some way as really innovative and total genius, but in reality, they may just be trying to shut down the operation.

So you want to watch that and watch the effects that this person who is apparently disruptive is having. Now then there are going to be the Aureus types who get it who understand that we're going to have to Follow a certain plan, stick to our guns, whatever it might be, or use real ideas, and those real ideas might in a sense be disruptive to something, but the purpose is not disruption, the purpose is an idea that gets something done.

So watch for these two types in group environments. And remember, your mind is represented by Pluto, Pluto wants to get to the bottom of things. And so that strongly favors doing a lot of getting to the bottom of things.

In this last section, let's cover three topics. The first one is the retrogrades of Venus and Mars. Let's just cover those very briefly. Mars is about to be retrograde that, that turns retrograde on the 6th with the Sun in Sagittarius. So that's right in the solar return signature.

And this is and the second one will be we'll do a little bit about Venus retrograde. And do we even cover the fifth house yet? Oh man, there's so much to cover. I think that's more important than these retrogrades.

So let's cover the fifth house. This is where, Saturn and Neptune are coming.

I will get to the retrogrades in the horoscope, I will get to them elsewhere. So let's, and then Uranus changing signs, very important. I talked a lot about the security issues the the sense of belonging and the wisdom of insecurity with Neptune and Saturn in the fourth.

This finds its answer as 2025 develops. And both of those points go into Aries.

And this is like the heart of the matter. I hope I didn't already cover this. It's been a very long day, but if I did already, don't worry, I'm going to say different things. To have Aries in the fifth place could not be better.

It does not get better than to have Ares in the fifth. Okay, there's a lot of good things in astrology, but that's very exciting. And here's why. The fifth is very creatively dynamic. Aries is the place where you feel the necessary, the urgent compulsion. To be yourself and to actualize as yourself.

This is the, be humbly who you aspire to be, which is not going to happen. The suggestion here is to be boldly who you aspire to be. And there's a certain kind of boldness indicated by Saturn entering Aries. Now is the time to do this. And then with Neptune going in, there is the, there, there is the necessity for envisioning, for a creative vision for who you are.

And this fits perfectly with the 165, the quintessile from sun, moon to Uranus, this thundering, practical obsession with being who you are. In true Sagittarius fashion, that's an extra sign of the Zodiac nobody's ever heard of, Neil deGrasse Tyson can talk about Ophiuchus all he wants, I say there is Sagittarius.

That there is a very important connection between Sagittarius and Taurus. That's the connection with Uranus. Moon, Sun, Gerania that I talked about at the very top of the reading, but that's just another version of planets going into Aries. So there is a synthesis here. There is about, in a sense, designing a new person.

It's not so much inventing as it is creating, but there's going to be a lot of inventive energy, but the quality of your of Saturn and Neptune together, working together, they're going to be working together for a year and a half before Saturn takes off and moves on forward, leaving Neptune.

There is this vast experimental period that you might imagine is some scientists in 1950 that are, that have made some discovery of some polymer that they can basically turn into anything and it's what can this stuff do? And what, then they've synthesized a new thing.

Well that's what this is about. It's about synthesizing a new concept of who you are. And this is something that is going to require taking a risk and something that

is going to require expression all factors of Aries in the fifth place. What else is going on in Ares in the fifth place?

And this is the awakening aspect this is the thing that's like the spark of the complete awakening is Chiron conjunct Eris now Eris has been in Aries since around 1922 so it takes a long time to go through Aries.

It takes 130 years to go through Aries. There's nothing really like it that we talk about. There's crazy things with long orbits, 15,000 years, but 130 years through one sign. That's pretty special. And it's due to the irregularity in Eris's orbit. It's like a huge, long period centaur. And Chiron is the original centaur.

Chiron has been in Eris since 2015, 2018. And that's the fifth house. Now the thing about the fifth is, it wants experience. There's nothing theoretical about the fifth house. The fifth house just breaks out the tools, breaks out the paints, breaks out the sporting set or the books, breaks out the rock climbing equipment, and it's just like let's make it, build it, paint it, climb it, do whatever.

Let's make a casino in the basement, and then we're gonna play for real money. That's the fifth house. It wants experience, and the fifth's also about sexual experience. And Chiron is in the fifth wants sexual experience. I realize this is not fashionable. It is not it does not fit this new neo feminism where men are not allowed to like women and women are not allowed to like men and the men are all going to stay together and the women are going to all stay together like it's a village in Africa.

Chiron in the fifth wants experience, and it wants to learn from experience, and grow from experience, and heal from experience. And it wants the experience that you want. Okay, so that's been going on since 2018. Now this is going to form a conjunction to Eris. This takes place basically between the sequence of these things. This is an astonishing chart set because it basically builds up starting now and then it makes three peaks.

It's May of 2025, October of 2025 and March of 2026. Big, bigger, biggest. And this is I would say genuinely revolutionary. The last time we experienced astrology like this, we meaning Western civilization, was in the early 1970s. And the early 1970s were a special time. They were not like the late 1970s, a very different time

in the late 1970s.

The me generation bullshit had not quite set in yet and the once Vietnam war ended, in 74, people were like ready to relax and have a good time. But before that, there was much more emphasis on self actualization. There were major innovations in therapy methods going on at this time.

Some very good teachers were in business and some exciting books were coming out. And so this is, it is going to provoke a drama in society. A big one. And it is going to provoke people to want to discover who they are. I cannot see any getting around this. Now we live, we also live in this superficial age of the internet, but the mischief maker with the internet, the disembodiment factor, the chaos maker, the ultimate queen of tribalization herself is Eris in Aries.

And Chiron is highly individualistic. Pretty much the first thing you learn about Chiron is it stands apart. It is the first keyword given to Chiron by its discoverer and astronomer, Charlie Kowal, he said, this thing is a maverick. It's not really a planet. It's not really an asteroid. It's very weird for a comet. There's no comets in this orbit. What is this thing? It's a centaur. It's a hybrid. It stands apart.

And so there, there is the potential for the healing of the tremendous damage to self concept and self actualization, self awareness, to sexuality, to authenticity, whatever words you like to use for that. Chiron is going to be very important answer to that.

And so we get a glorious Stretch of time, that I think is going to be the very peak of Chiron in Aries, is going to be the conjunction of Chiron and Eris in Aries. And you get this in your fifth house, where there is tremendous self discovery, and the self discovery largely manifests through creative expression.

Creative expression meaning bold, meaning focused on pattern recognition, seeing patterns in yourself. Taking chances, actualizing yourself in ways you never imagined possible, breaking out of the mold, breaking out of the algorithm, which is the bane of our time, is that these algorithms are teaching us to think algorithmically, and to not want to go off script.

I promise you as best I've ever made an open prediction, I don't really make too

many of them. They're not easy to make, and things are kaleidoscopic right now. There's going to be a lot of going off script happening beginning in the spring of 2025, even sooner as this conjunction approaches, when these planets switch to direct motion, they're currently retrograde.

And so this means that you get to go off script and that self creative energy will be unleashed. I am suggesting here just be as fully present with yourself and for yourself as you can. And if you are obsessed with the twin flames thing, 'oh my god, I'm not a complete person without this other person'.

Maybe consider that's like not the best way to live. Because it hems you in. And if you're thinking, wow, this really hems me in, maybe that's the advantage that it has for you. But owing to another factor, that's going to be radically tested.

And that other factor is Uranus, the lightning bolt in a planet, the very disrupter itself, the ultimate inventor, the thief of fire from the gods given to mankind so that he could have innovations like art and science, is the planet Uranus, which probably is misnamed best called Prometheus.

I don't know exactly how I was reading about Herschel, the discoverer, who is quite an incredible guy. If you like reading about these historical figures who really were scientists in the day when science was actually science, which basically is the 17th century.

Once you get into the 17th, Uranus is discovered, and there's all kinds of stuff going on. By the time we get into the 19th century, science becomes so full of shit, it's unrecognizable. But the really bold figures, the ones who were willing to risk everything, were in the 17th, And the 18th centuries, people like Galileo and Sir Isaac and and Herschel anyway, Herschel, that's the H in Uranus.

If you're wondering why the glyph has an H that's for its discoverer, William Herschel and this influence is about to dip some degrees into Gemini. It will make a transition that basically lasts between around May of 25 and probably going to wrap up around February of 26.

And there, there are accelerations with Uranus at each stage. There's accelerations and defined distinct moments for all these planets, but Uranus

tends to be very quick. For example, when Uranus went into Pisces. That very day, it was March 11th, 2011, something like that. It was the Fukushima nuclear disaster.

And this is time within hours of a Uranus sign change. I believe that was Aquarius into Pisces. So here's the thing about this, and I know I've been talking around the point for the last five minutes, but this is going to touch your relationship house, Gemini. And there is described a sequence of events that transform your concept of what a relationship is.

This is much more important than transforming any one relationship. It's very likely to do that as well. But it's also going to transform your entire notion of what a relationship is. Now the question is, will this work with somebody you might be with? Will it work for you? But here's where the self reinventive thing keeps happening.

Within the parameters of the lots you're building on the available materials. You have a lot of options for how you define yourself, how you invent yourself, how you how you self create. And yet, the known order is going to be revised. It will be tested. There will be vibrations at first, maybe some shock waves at first.

And so this is where really keeping communication lines open is essential. This is the essential thing in relationships, particularly when you've got Gemini on the seventh house cusp. Gemini is the sign of the twins who speak the secret language with one another. And I found this hilarious, I think I linked it from the horoscope, this hilarious video of two twins having this conversation.

In what sounds like baby talk, only they're responding to one another, like two English professors talking about Shakespeare, only it just sounds like baby talk and they're having this conversation where they completely agree on what is so. They're in diapers sitting on the kitchen floor in front of the refrigerator.

That's idioglossia. That's Gemini, the secret language of twins. So communicate with the people in your life, recognize when you're growing, recognize when they're growing, notice when growth is happening, notice when there's a need for growth happening, notice when there's something that you just have to talk about, have check in sessions, and more than anything, be ready to ride with the

tide and go with the flow.

Only this tide and this flow are going to be more electrical and airy in nature. We've lost Pluto in Capricorn, and I say lost because it's a feminine sign. We're losing slowly over the next year half or so planets in Pisces. There's a strong emphasis on the masculine signs that's developing.

We're going to have Saturn, Neptune, and Pluto in masculine signs going forward for quite a while. And that is just saying we need to stay in contact with Awa. Awa, the feminine principle, the encompassing principle, the soft and pliable principle that is the essence of the feminine principle.

That's what it's called in Japanese. And its opposite is in English. Sanuki, which does not feel so pliable, Sanuki is the, Sanuki is the lady running around in charge of everything, she's 24 years old and she can move at the speed of light, and she's got three iPods, and she's got them all talking to each other, and she knows exactly what exactly has to happen now.

That's the opposite principle. What I'm suggesting here is stay in contact with your Awa. Stay male or woman, male or female, man or woman. However you think about that, the principle of Awa remains the same. If you can do all this, the great reward described in your chart is Jupiter going into Cancer.

That's pretty Awa. That has that pliable, spongy, encompassing feeling. There is a gift in that. They, these planets change at the same time. Uranus goes into Gemini right around the same time that Jupiter goes into Cancer, where I think it stays, I don't think there's a retrograde back. And the way to read that astrologically is that there will be a reward, personal, emotional reward for being willing to shift your concept of what a relationship is, which is just an outgrowth of expanding, revising, transforming your concept or allowing it to be so of who you are and daring, daring to be self expressive.

I get that Sagittarius, if you look at any astrology book, the word shy will not come up. But the world right now is this big project of trying to silence people. or make them feel irrelevant, I mean there's, 20 bazillion websites, how's anybody ever gonna see yours.

Alright, that is my message for you. Venus and Mars retrograde another time. Just check that out. I will most definitely be covering them in the Awakening. I'm up to Libra.
