

Aquarius Astrology Studio 2025-26

Thanks for joining me and thanks for purchasing your Aquarius reading. And for your patience around this time of year, as I jump back in to more regularly scheduled stuff after three months of doing the annual edition it's a little bit tricky and then there's the content piece of it, I've just done this reading where I've said everything I could possibly say.

I think the Aquarius reading ran about 7, 000 words or something like that.

All right. Part of the game upping here is a better camera, better light and new background art.



That's the oldest art on earth out of the Lascaux cave. In France, and I think that's interesting that what they didn't really portray humans very much in that art and it's a vastly complex cave system with art, basically on all of the walls and they did a lot of running animals, particularly horses and what seems to be bison.

And there is one image that depicts a bird man, I'm pretty sure, but my personal favorite are these hands reaching out of the abyss 20,000 years ago, and a dog named Robot found the opening to the cave in a what was basically a tree turned over and left a little hole in the ground.

And Mr. Robot found this opening and a few days later the guy, I don't even remember who the person was I just remember the dog, of course, brought some friends back and they went into the cave. They had to make, they couldn't go to Home Depot or Lowe's, they had to make a kind of a makeshift gas lamp.

And they went down there. This is around 1940, 1942, something like that, so the Lascaux Cave. All right, but we're here to talk about Aquarius in this moment where Aquarius is very much the thing to talk about. All the themes and the dynamics and the issues of Aquarius are going to be basically front and center in our lives.

I think they have been since the events of 2020 which we cannot discount as being one of the strangest incidents of the entire modern era. And there have

been a lot of there have been a lot of very strange ones, but never before have the streets of the world been emptied... ever first of all.

And then second, it should surprise no one to know that this was over the claim of a virus that turns out to only exist in artificial intelligence programs, now, these are two very Aquarian themes, one the streets of the world being emptied, and then this issue of artificial intelligence, and, I know I've said these things, and if you're one of these people who's curious about, and haven't been listening to my work the past five years, and might fire back, how did all those people die, well if you've ever watched a true crime program how did that dead body get dead is one of the most important questions of dead bodies is how did that dead body get dead, except when it's said to be medical and they can just check off a cause of death on the on the death certificate.

And one of those is not "we killed you". It's, "was it that disease or that disease?" This third theme of how did that dead body get dead is significant when we talk about Pluto, the Lord of death entering Aquarius, the Lord of Groups. So thing one is the entire social pattern of the world was changed overnight, March 13th, 2020, and second, And This was all done using artificial intelligence to create the metagenomic transcript that was called SARS CoV 2.

The official name is MN908947.2. And then the artificial intelligence so called test called the polymerase chain reaction. And then third, if people died, how did people get dead? And that's the Pluto. They're all about Pluto, but the they happened under the influence of Saturn in Aquarius and Saturn in Aquarius is it's somewhat less than Pluto in Aquarius.

Pluto is very concentrated and affects more people. And there is a denial trip going on around Pluto as being the edge of the solar system which we encountered in the summer of 2007 when Mike Brown, the person who discovered the planet, Aris brown, also discovered he discovered Sedna, Brown discovered Haumea, I think Maki Maki and they've all got exotic weird names.

Because they're running out of Greek gods and Roman gods to name things after. Brown has Pluto demoted. He discovers Eris, far out from Pluto, in our solar system, but he's got to finish the job and basically try to make himself into the most famous astronomer on Earth.

By having Pluto demoted. Demoting Pluto is something of a power trip. He wrote a book called *How I Killed Pluto. Or Why I Killed Pluto*. And I have talked to Mike Brown. I have indirectly worked on a project with Mike Brown.

Mike Brown advocates for astrologers. But I think that this was something approaching the height of arrogance to claim that he killed Pluto.

This beautiful thing that's a six planet system. There's nothing like Pluto anywhere. So we call Pluto a planet. It's just this round rock. And it's got a moon going around it, named Charon. I've heard it pronounced Karen but it's not really a moon. They're a binary pair of minor planets, and they orbit a common barycenter, and then outside of them there's four additional orbiting points.

And so this incredibly beautiful thing the way of first getting to understand and as an astronomical entity thanks to better telescopes and the new horizons mission has entered Aquarius it's entered your sign and it has entered your sign in the 18 month warmup and 18 month lead in. Impressive, right?

It made three entries, whereas normally an outer planet will make two entries. It'll go into the new sign retrograde out and then go back in over about a nine month period. We almost double that with the entry of Pluto into Aquarius for some odd reason. How that works out between the orbit of Pluto and the orbit of the Earth around the sun, through some combination of factors Pluto made an additional retrograde back into Capricorn that ended in November.

And so we had 10 weeks from about September of 2024 out to November of 2024, where there is one last extra bit of Pluto in Capricorn. And I was talking about using that as the occasion to wrap up old business, Capricorn related, meaning family and government.

And so now Pluto is in Aquarius and this, of course. It represents an important part of demarcation in your life, wherever your sun happens to be in Aquarius. If you're born on very early Aquarius, let me see if I can get this straight. Something like what, it's January, let's say you're born January 20th.

You're going to have Pluto conjunct the sun now, basically, January 9th. Whatever the entrance entry date is, I don't have these dates in my head right now. If your birthday is today, you're not going to have Pluto on your sun for about nine more years.

But we know, we sun sign writers know. That when a planet enters a sign, the entire energy field is activated, and you don't even need to be a sun sign writer. You just need to be a mundane astrologer to see the incredible things that happen when a planet changes signs, like the Fukushima incident that happened when Uranus went from I believe Aquarius to Pisces in 2011.

Earlier in my career, there were fewer of these transits I had to memorize. When I started, like the 21st century hadn't happened yet. And now that we're here at this late date, the 21st century is definitely happening. I think that the thing that we all remember about the 21st century, besides something like 9/11, which really begins the digital age, there were several events in 2000 and 2001 that begin the digital age, which I'm calling full digital conditions.

Really the demarcation point is pretty easy to spot based on certain cultural markers like 9/11, like Y2K, like the stolen election of 2000, which was symbolized by the guy looking up at the punch card. Remember the dimple Chad, Photo by Alan Diaz. But when we really think of the 21st century and what happened, and in particular what would appear to be the humans submitting to the total supremacy of artificial intelligence, and I don't mean your Google search, somebody tried to give me a noodle lashing for quoting an AI search engine result, that's the least of our worries.

Frankly what we need to be worried about, and I think we “need”, strong word, to be “worried”, another strong word, and therefore take action upon rather than sitting around being worried. Is this extent of the use of AI requiring Bill Gates to lease the Three Mile Island nuclear power plant.

Are you old enough to remember the Three Mile Island nuclear meltdown? I think that was in 79. There's still half of the thing left. They decommissioned it and Gates has basically leased it for 20 years. Why does he need to lease a power plant that big? We need to, I want to show you this.

I'Because it's really important for this reading. If you want to understand Pluto and Aquarius, then we're going to get into how Pluto and Aquarius influences you. So let's get this thing up here on the screen. Oh, very nice. We've got 2300, we've got a relatively generous 2300 pixels left.

I want to show you this motherfucker. Now you've seen this before. But I want to help you understand what this is. And I'm not totally certain on which of these is Unit 1 and which is which is Unit 2. But let's share the screen.



This unit is the one that melted down (left two stacks). You can see they have completely dismantled all the equipment that was used to get the water into these cooling towers.

This is the one (middle right stack) that Gates is going to rent, lease. They're going to recommission it. They're going to take it out of sleep mode. They're going to recommission it. Why does he need all this power?

To fuel, to power a massive artificial intelligence complex in Pennsylvania. What are we going to do with that? Why do we need that? We don't need it. Humans don't need it. We don't need artificial intelligence. We need natural intelligence. Take one good look at that. I rode my bicycle all the way there from New York City.

That's how badly I wanted to see it. It's something like 270 miles. That's right. I convinced three of my friends to get on our bicycles and ride from New York City to Harrisburg PA.

So what is happening is that. Humans have now passed the turning point where we have any hope of our technology being the product of our own minds. From the point of generative AI forward the machines will invent the machines. So there's no more tinkering in the lab. No more soldering no more creative problem solving unless of course you believe in notebooks, doodling until you doodle yourself into your next brilliant idea.



So bear in mind what has happened in particular, what happened to you in 2021 and 22. Those were the main years of Saturn and Aquarius.

And, ask yourself... I'm putting this question to everyone, but ask yourself how you responded. Ask yourself, did you raise your threshold for accepting something as true, or did you lower your threshold for accepting something as true? And all the astrology books tell us, maybe not all of them, but it's generally a perception of astrology that Aquarians are the real brainiacs of the of the Zodiac

I've got Aquarius, moon and Saturn and Pholus and QB one, you, we are the brainiacs. When they announced this shit was going down in March of 2020, did you raise your bar on, on, on what you were accepting as true? Did you lower the bar on what you were accepting as true?

Or did you light the fucking bar on fire and say, "Fauci's never been wrong before. And look at this highly trustworthy president we have. Oh he knows what's going on".

I encourage an honest reflection, an honest deconstruction of how you responded, what you believe. Now next, Aquarius question for 2020, and I promise we'll get to Pluto, but we're warming up.

We're warming up for Pluto here. So Aquarius is said to be the sign of groups. Okay, a group implies an **in** group and an **out** group. A group implies that certain people are included and certain people are excluded. Otherwise we're

talking about talking about like a parade where anybody can show up and dogs know exactly what to do.

If you notice how dogs just you get a parade plus human, bring your dog, the dog knows how to march in the parade. How do they know that? Humans also know how to march in the parade, but Aquarius is not the parade. That's Pisces. Aquarius is the in group and the out group.

And so when this whole thing happened in 2020, which side were you on? Were you on the side “You can't come to Thanksgiving dinner unless you've been all injected and have you're up to your current boosters”. Or were you on the side of, “I've never worried about this before, or why all of a sudden are we so profoundly concerned about whether a cousin Billy or Aunt Claudia have had their shots all of a sudden.”

“And we've all had our shots. Why should we worry? If there's one person who hasn't had their shots.” So for example the reason why wildlife workers get rabies shots, assuming this is real, which it's just completely, it's completely out there. The reason why wildlife workers get their rabies shot as in case they get bit by a rabid dog. There are this is watch the Bailey's video on rabies, just as an example. So which side were you on? Were you on the side of let's include people or let's exclude people?

And Aquarians are also thought of as being the ardent individualists of Zodiac. We Are always going to be ourselves. Okay. Was the ardent individual known as yourself willing to contradict your values? Or it may say it's an awfully rushed job for a vaccine. They keep saying on the news vaccines take seven to 10 years to make.

This one took two weeks. What am I going to do?

What did you do with that thing? What did you do with that thing is going to be the question of Pluto and Aquarius also. In fact, what do you do with that thing is the question of life. It is the question of, here we are, you're born in a body. The brain in a human is a big deal. A lovely pelvis of the female can only bump out so far during the childbirth process.

So the baby comes out half formed, basically. That's why human infants are like, baby deer, gets up and walks around like in five minutes. A baby human is like gurgling and nursing for three years, before it can do too much eventually learns the zip code and stuff like that.

And that's for brain development. Our brains are rather partially formed when we're born and are still forming in into the late teenage years hopefully. And if you really are an intelligent person you're you keep developing your thoughts. You keep developing your brain all throughout your life.

Here is an Aquarian theme, but what happens with Aquarius is, this could be anything in Aquarius, is “Well I already know that. I don't need to think about that. I already know that. I'm an expert. Or, I just think I'm an expert. Or, I think I know.” And I will say now, with Pluto fully activating your sign, possibly crossing over your ascendant, or your moon, or your sun. The words, if I were to condense them for an Aquarius studio would be “Know when you don't know”. This is the model of Aquarius.

So one of the things I do is I train investigative reporters, I trained reporters to be investigators and non reporters to basically start journalism as investigative reporters. Knowing when you don't know is also the theme of investigative reporting.

How do you know when you don't know? I thought about this for years before I actually figured out a good answer to it. And the way that you know when you don't know is you have to ask yourself how you know everything. You constantly check. How do I know that? How do I know that? Everything that you think you know.

Every time you say, I know, or I believe, How do you know? How do you, why do you believe? Why do you believe any one thing that you believe? When you start to fact check this stuff and I don't mean fact checking like factcheck.org, that's a complete con job. By fact check I mean checking your attributions.

That's all fact checking is. Fact checking is not establishing the truth. Fact checking is verifying attributions. What's your attribution on that fact? Did your mother tell you when you were five? Did your uncle tell you when you were seven? Did your fifth grade Science teacher tell you like in, in 1978.

How do you know? So the only way to find out that when you don't know, unless you are very sensitive to it. Some people such as me are very sensitive to this sinking hollow feeling of not knowing how I know that. And of course I can't sit here and seriously say according to my gut.

According to my gut, Elon Musk is a pretty good guy. All those teenagers he's got running the department of the treasury right up on the top floor. How do you know what you know? So you got to keep asking yourself, how do you know

that? How do you know that? Because under Pluto and Aquarius conditions, it's going to be a lot of situations where you're going to need to know what's true from what's not true.

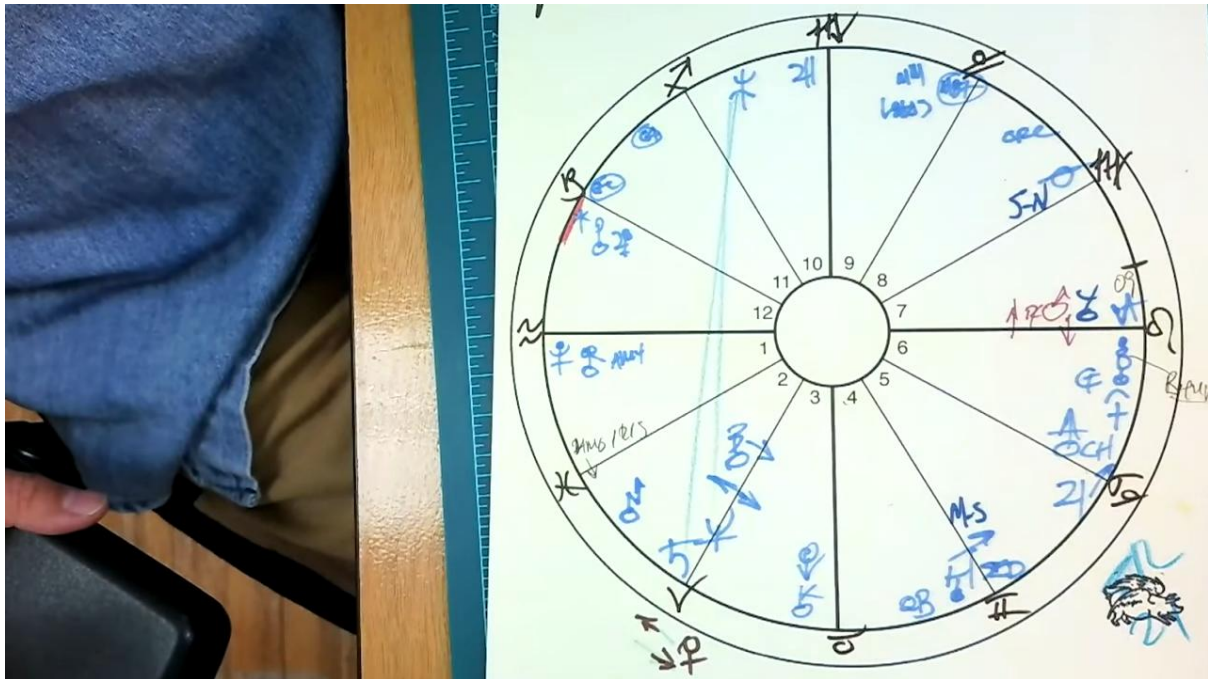
You're going to need to know what's real from what's not real, motherfucker. You've got to know this. Because you are likely to be in some form of a position of leadership among friends and family. People are going to gravitate towards you with Pluto in Aquarius. They're going to sense that power, and they're going to, and they're going to trust you even more than they normally might.

You're going to be feeling your power. You're going to be feeling your influence. Great time to start a video podcast. You'll have a million viewers in five minutes. Monetize that shit and get some weight loss ads going. How do you know when you don't know? You got to keep asking yourself, how do I know that?

How do I know that? How do I know that? Or you can recognize that sinking feeling. That sense of standing on quicksand when you realize you don't know how the fuck you know that, which means you probably don't know it.

All right, so why is this so important? We all know that I'm like Mr. Research Astrologer and I've delineated all these minor planets and do all that, but I love Sun Sign Astrology. And one of the reasons why I love Sun Sign Astrology is that it eliminates the number of variables, which opens up a kind of a free. play space.

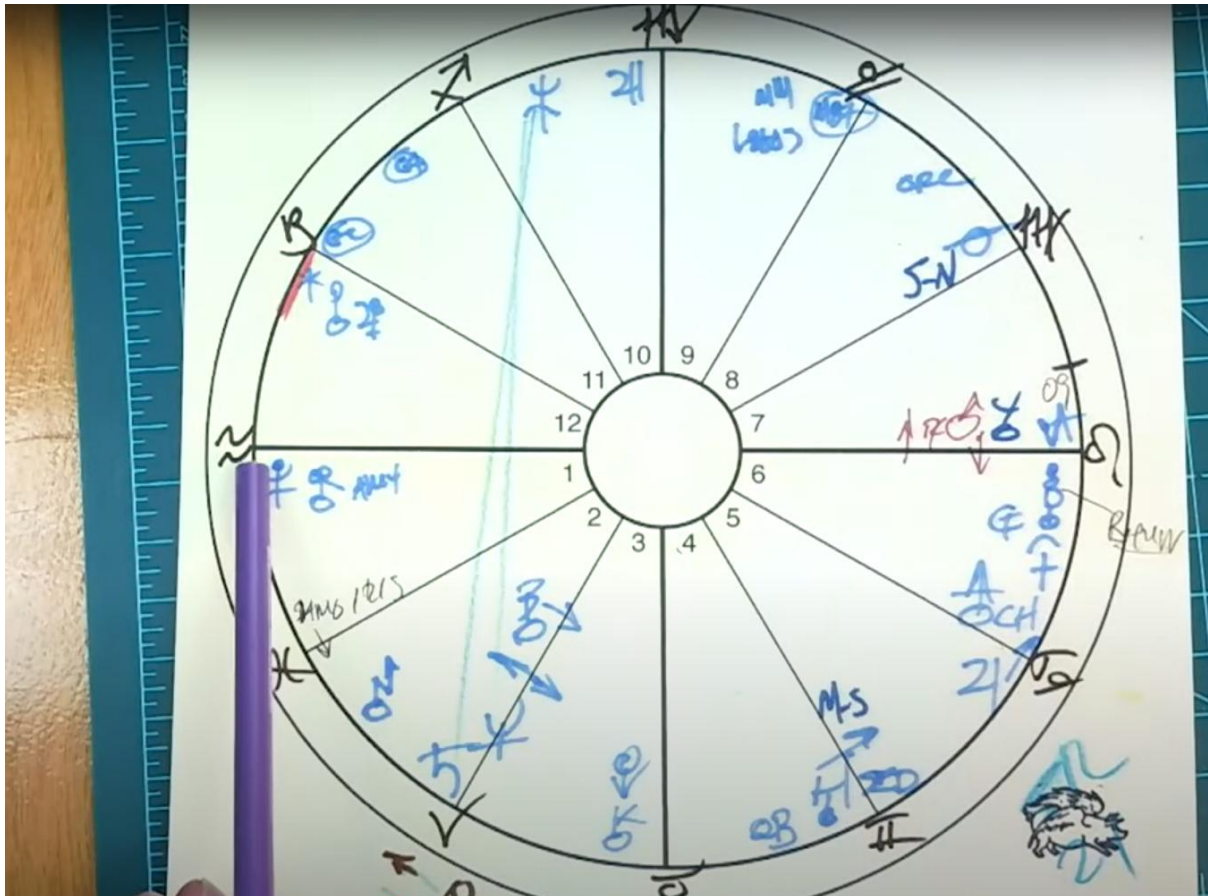
Aquarius 2025 plus. Let's get this right. And this is the new technological innovation here in the astrology studio of Planet Waves.



This is the Aquarius solar chart. It's the same chart I used for The Awakening which got an astounding 7,000 word written reading followed only by Pisces, which got the world's only 9,000 words sun sign horoscope.

Who says there's not information here? There is information here. It gets a lot of stuff out of the way. The thing this chart gets out of the way is the personal ego. That's good to mundane astrology too. And we get this look, this bird's eye view looking top down at this chart.

And this is the advantage of any form of divination. Rune divination, you're looking down at it. Tarot card divination, you're looking down at it. You start reading a chart, generally speaking, on the left side, and here we see Pluto.

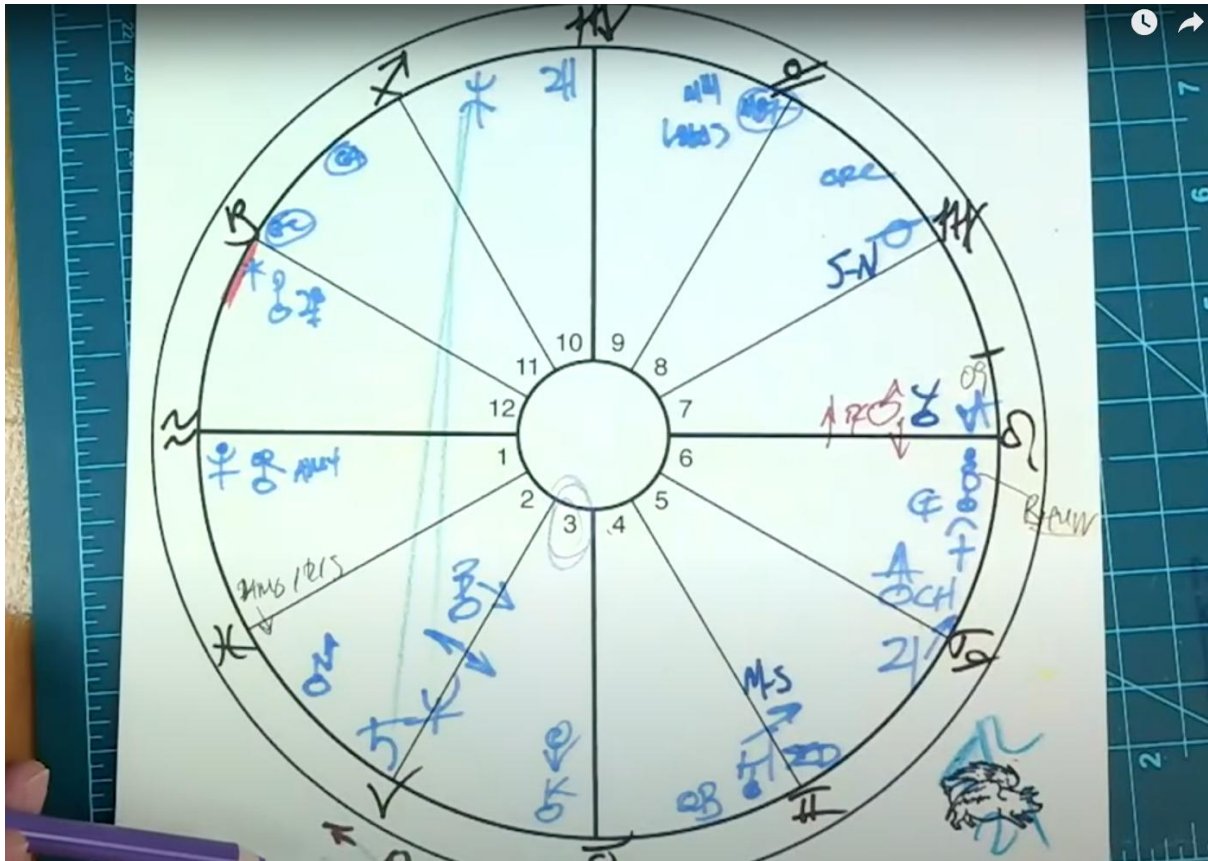


Pluto also, by the way, joined by two centaurs, Aureus and Amicus, both slow movers not as slow as Pluto, so they're going to be running, Aureus and Amicus are going to be running vanguard of Pluto for a while, 10 years or so.

I'll get into a bit about what they're about. Here's my favorite discovery of late, reading the sun sign chart of Aquarius. It's called the solar chart.

The notion that Aquarians are idea people, you can get that from observation. There's more of an ability to conceive things in the abstract with Aquarius, I think. There's a bit of dominance of the masculine brain. The masculine brain is capable of capable of thinking of things in the abstract, like calculus.

But there's something else here. And that is that if we look at Aquarius and we count to, to find the location of Aries, we find out that it is in house number three.



And house number three should have a kind of a light bulb because house number three is the house of ideas. It's the house of local communication.

It is the house of local mercantile activities. It is the house of one's speaking style, one's thinking style, and one's writing style. And generally, it is the house where we have ideas and express those ideas. It's also the house of neighbors. And brethren, siblings. It has this very close in feeling to it.

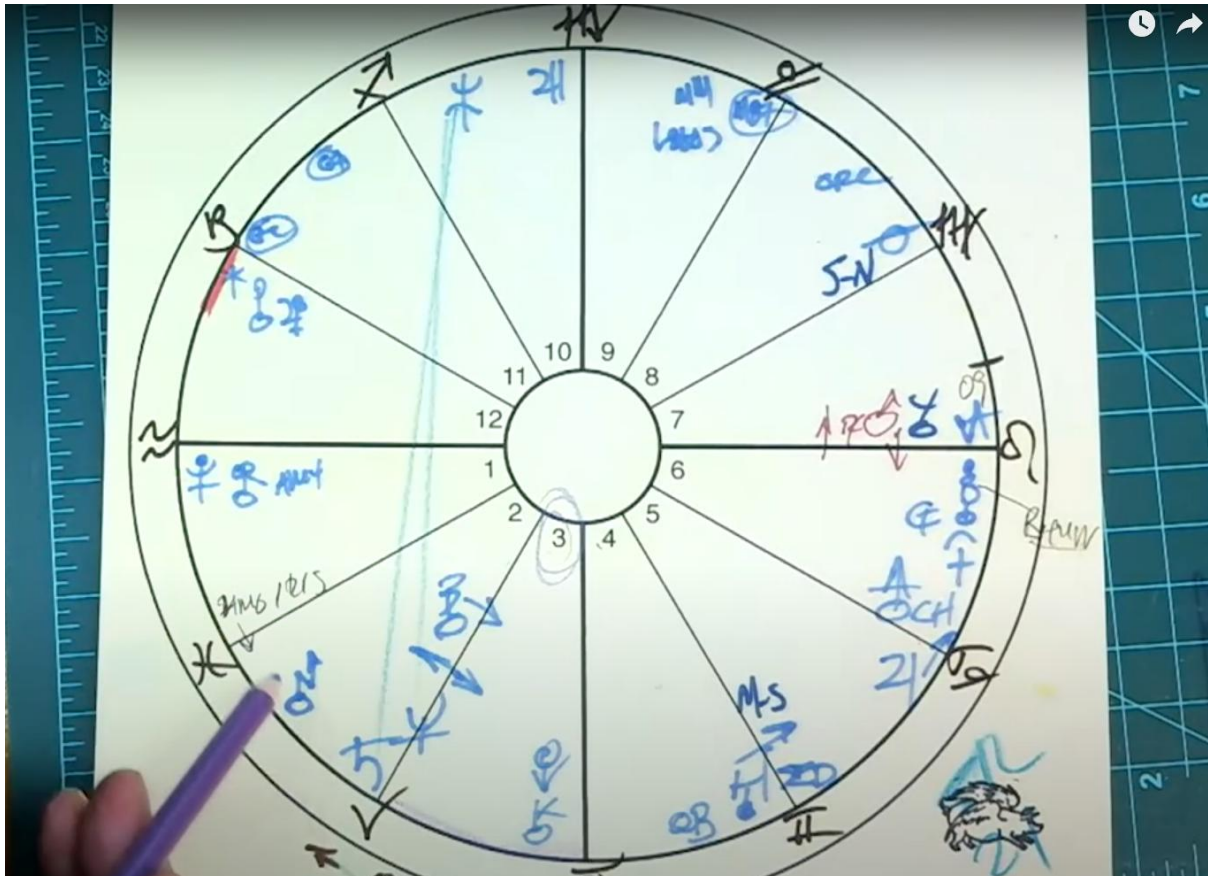
And you have Aries there. And one of my sun sign theories developed, it is a theory in response to doing much work with sun signs, is that where you have Aries, in your chart, solar chart or natal chart, in this case, the solar chart, where you have Aries is that with which you identify. So that is where you are likely to seek a good portion of your personhood.

It's like where you have areas is one of the primary places that you're standing when you say, I am, it's like the room that you are in. Houses are, they're not so much houses as they are rooms in this one huge, big, complicated house. We've talked about what happened when Saturn came through Aquarius.

That was 2020 into 2021, into 2022. And we've talked a little bit about Pluto in Aquarius. Focusing group versus individual dynamics. And I'll run through

those in a second. But let's talk about how it feels to be in Aquarius. One of the ways we know it feels to be in Aquarius from the inside of being in Aquarius is where we find Ares, and you find Ares in place number three.

First house says I am, but it's how you present yourself to the world. The second house is what you possess and what you value. You have Pisces here.



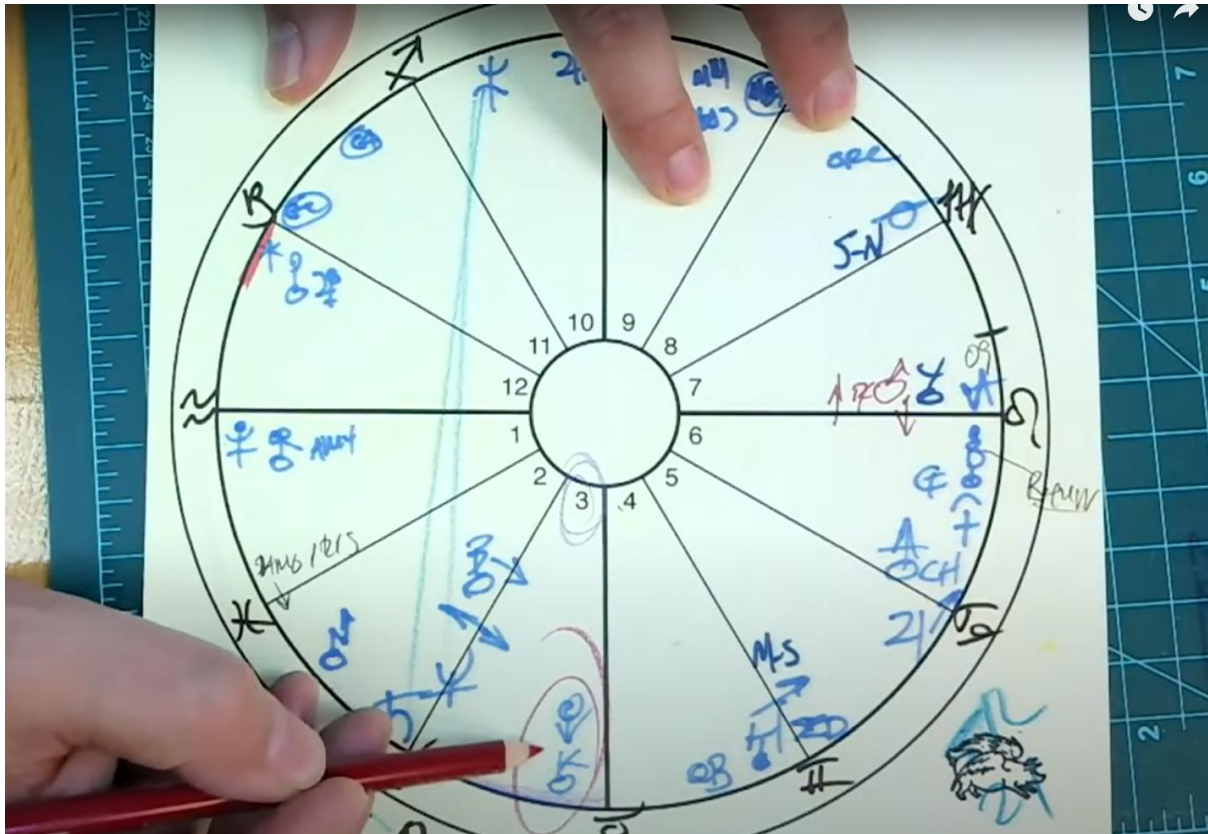
This is the water part of the water bearer in Pisces. The water bearer has the container. What the container contains is the water from Pisces in house 2.

That's your values, principles, and priorities. And then by house three, you're ready to say, "Oh, by the way, I am". And what you're saying I am about is, I am my ideas. Really it is a very strong sense of local consciousness that I think is extraordinarily important to Aquarius. There, there are signs that strongly emphasize going far afield, but at least for the purpose of grounding, like putting something on the ground that you can stand on.

Your local environment is very inspiring for you. It has to be very inspiring for you. And that is going to be closely associated with, again, how you think, how you speak, how you frame your ideas. And how you buy and sell. And I don't

mean buying and selling on the internet. I mean buying and selling at the farmer's market. Okay. And there's two major things about to happen here.

Thing one that's about to happen here is let's use red for emphasis, is these two planets, which have been in Aries a long time, Aris since the 1920s, Chiron since around 2018, are going to form a conjunction in Aries.



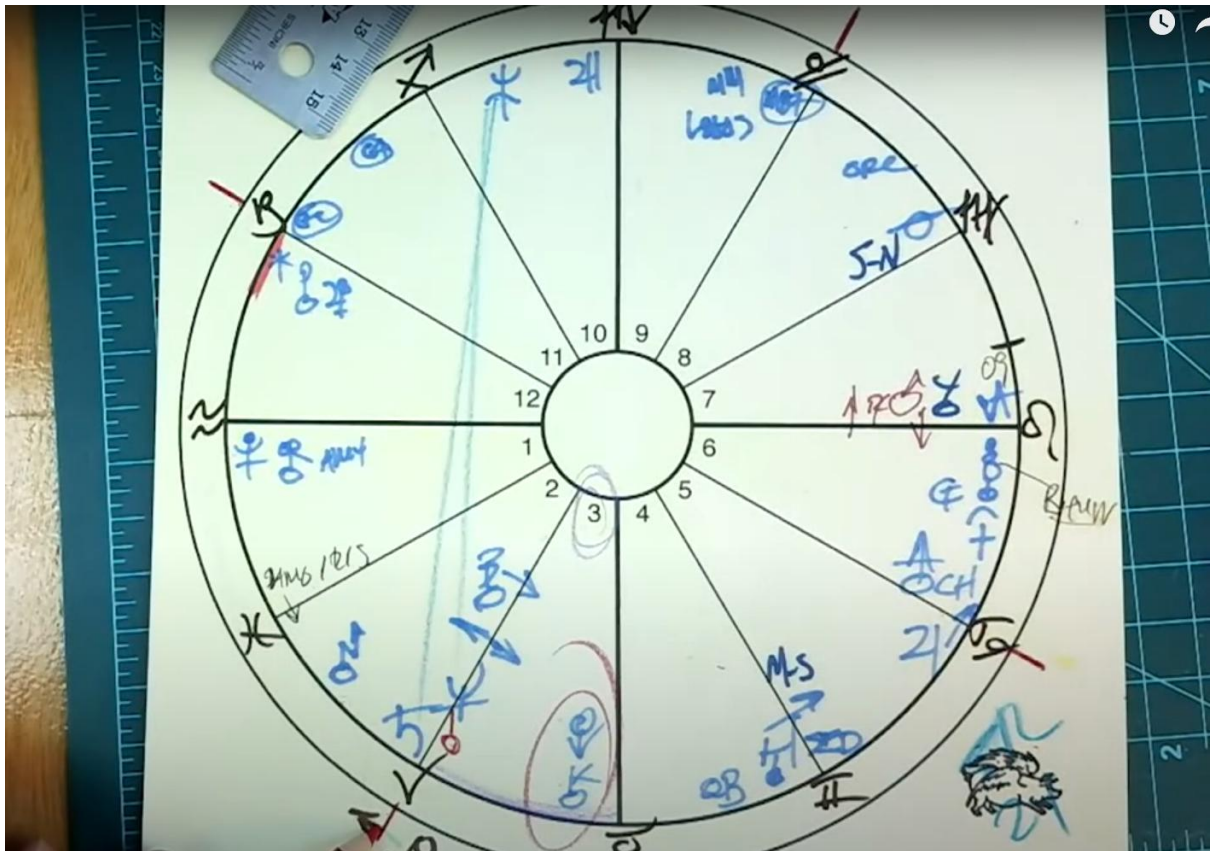
This is very strong emphasis. It is very strong emphasis on your idea making potential, your idea making capacity, because this is where these things In the symbolic, schematic of astrology, this is where they happen.

Then, the next thing is happening. Neptune has been in Pisces since the 2012 era. It comes in, I believe, in 2011. And Saturn has been in Pisces since basically mid 2022, out till now, and it takes a while to get in, it takes a while to get out. And where out is going to go is Aries.

Neptune's going in first, real soon, followed by Saturn, then they retrograde back, then they're going to form a conjunction on the Aries point.

Called the Great Reconciliation of Accounts and Humanity.

The Aries Point branches out into First Degree Cancer, First Degree Libra, and First Degree Capricorn, as well as First Degree Aries.



So that's why if I say, "oh, Jupiter's crossing the Aries Point", yeah, Jupiter's going to enter Cancer in June, I think, and it's going to make a square to the Aries point. That's Aries point enough.

And then the other bits of the Aries point are the midpoints of the fixed signs, such as where the sun is now in the middle of your sign, the sun in the middle of Aquarius.

So the Aries point branches out to the cardinal points, and then it branches out to the midpoint of the cardinal points. It is very influential and so to the extent to which you are identified and affiliated with your own ideas.

This is a glorious time to be alive, and this emphasizes third house activities such as writing and speaking of any kind but you can safely warm your talks up at the local library, or in case you're not the like big bold adventurous type by joining Toastmasters.

If you want a good time, this is the world. Look up Toastmasters International, and look up the winning speeches from last year's convention.

But locally, Toastmasters is not like that. Toastmasters is just giving a talk. I suggest that no matter how shy you are. You give some talks and you become very comfortable with speaking to people, particularly with a small groups is a good place to start for practice, because what you want with all of this third house Aries, remembering that Aries is where everyone says "I am".

It just depends on where Aries is in the chart. For the sun signs, there's 12 locations. For the rising signs, there's 12 locations. For Aquarius, "I am" is said in the third house, and the third house is writing, speaking, buying, selling locally, your neighbors, your brethren, meaning your siblings, and the style of how you think.

Now, if we recall that Aquarius has, and I've got a, if I had been preparing this reading in advance, I would have just gone to rush order tees and invested one of your subscription fees for this reading and I would have had a shirt that said "know when you don't know" with Aquarius. I'm going to make that shirt and you will see me in a podcast with it. I've got to get the right Aquarius symbol.

Know when you don't know. So that indicates a potentially rigid thought pattern.

Aquarians are not easy to reason with. And I suggest you take what you think you know and put it on a table. And stand back from the table and walk around and look at it and say, how do I know that? What's that? What's this artifact of thought here? What's this artifact of thought here?

Because the way you want to think, the way you need to think is in an Aries fashion. New, interesting, immediate, local, documentable, visible, sensible, tangible. Do you know the names of the local merchants that you buy things from? Very helpful telling you farmers markets are very important right now.

When I was living in Paris and Paris had the best markets, every neighborhood had one block where there were these little holes in the ground about the size of a soup can, deeper but about the size of a soup can, a lot of them and you know if every Tuesday night in my neighborhood somebody would drop off all these like tents, basically, and about four o'clock in the morning on Wednesday, a bunch of guys would show up and erect the tents, the market would happen, the market would be over by one or two o'clock, the guys would come, remove the tents, hose down the street, and quickly bring them to the next neighborhood.

I realized how important these markets were. And this was in 2005 and 2006. Now we live in a time when Amazon Marketplace, Facebook Marketplace, everyone's selling their shit online. This defeats the vital importance that commerce and trade have served for the human race since long, before Marco Polo was a gleam in his mother's eye.

Marco Polo shows up late to the game of trade routes. They're like, we got to trade. We got to trade between Egypt and India. What do you do with all that? If you want to buy some like Egyptian cotton in France, you need a market.

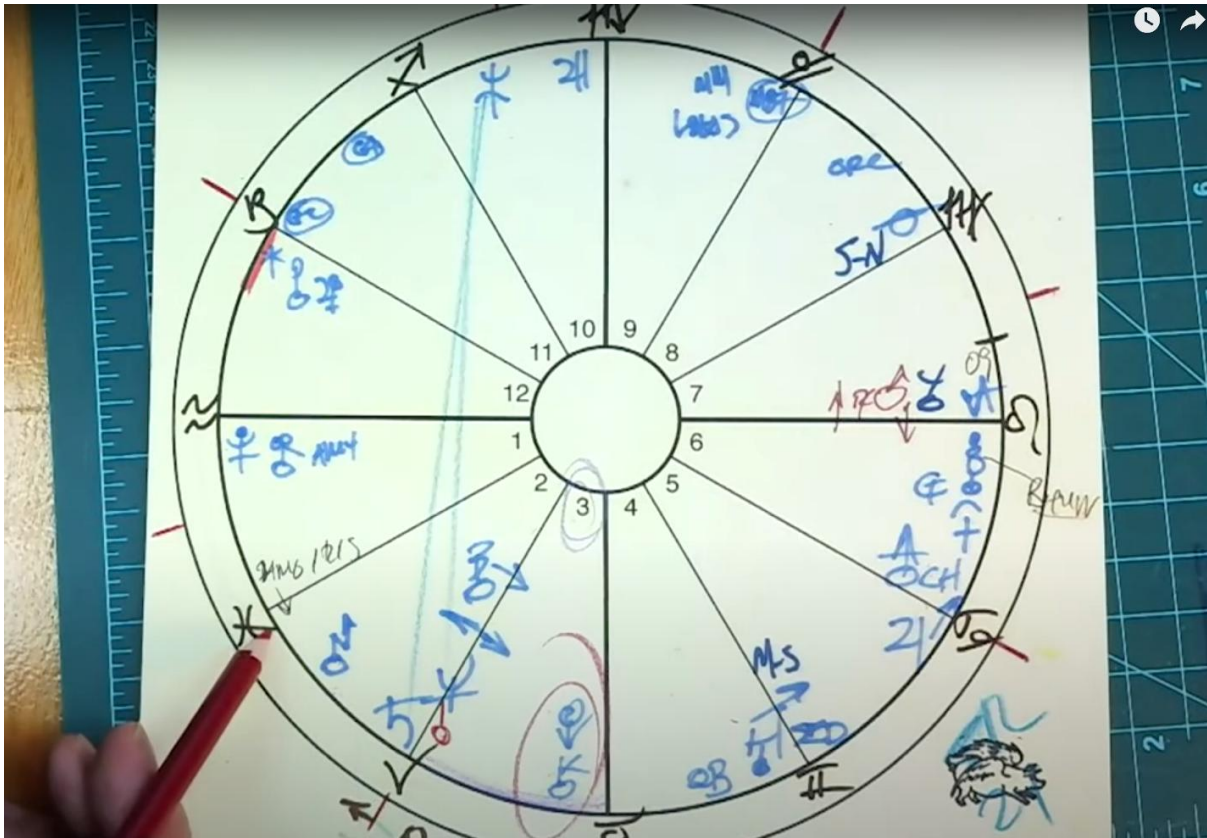
So the market, and I'm not talking about Adam Smith's market, I'm talking about the farmer's market. The market is the apotheosis of humanity, the farmer's market. And if you go to the farmer's market and meet the farmers, you're going to learn a lot, especially now with your astrology lighting the fuck out of Aries and focusing you on some immediate here now reality. Look, I love the internet as much as the next guy.

Here and now, the internet is the very antithesis of here and now. It's like here everywhere. I'm talking to you as if you're sitting in the room. You're not sitting in the room. You may be sometime tonight. In reality. I'm sitting here. Talking to myself. I just happen to be good at it. I'm very convincing.

And it seems like I'm talking to you, doesn't it? I'm talking right to, I mean you, but it's gonna be like eight hours or eight days, or eight years or something later. Maybe the explorers of this civilization will come across the entire internet, like the Lasko Cave.

Some little dog is gonna find a bunch of disk drives somewhere. Gonna find the server farm. Gonna find Three Mile Island. They're gonna know from the radiation. They're gonna use their Geiger counter. And find the entire internet.

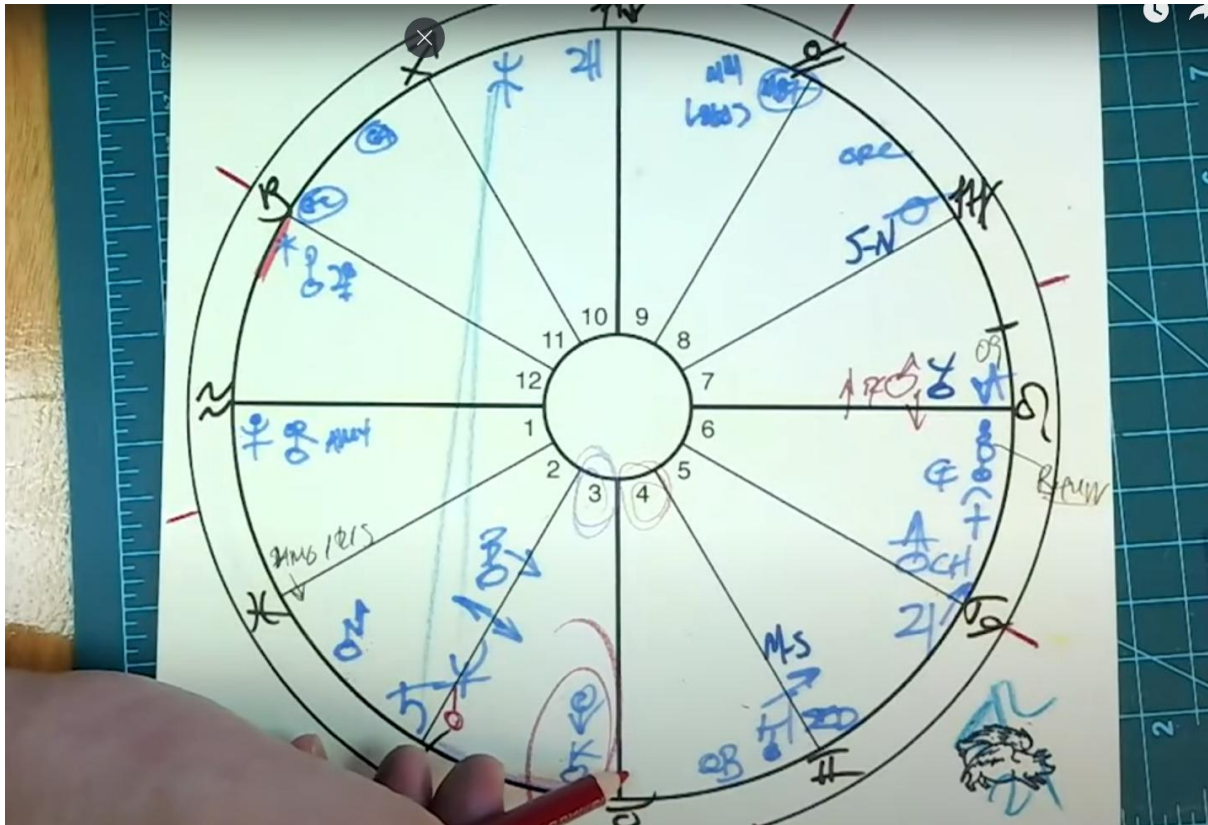
Alright, let's keep talking about your chart. I'm having fun doing this. I ought to do this again. Alright, back to your chart. Let's see. And I'm really, I'm gonna really stick with highlights here. Even though we've had a lot of details. Alright, we've done this house. Let's talk briefly about Pisces. Second place.



This is the soft side of Aquarius. This is where, if Aquarius has a reputation for being humanitarian. To the extent that is true. Humanitarian and idealistic. It comes from Pisces in the second house, your house of values. Alright, but Pisces value being like, anybody with sensitive Pisces, anybody who's a sensitive person, which means they have Pisces working, would never leave an animal in distress, ever.

I love how fast I don't think about it. How quickly I've made the decision that critter in crisis is going to be on my back seat. It's going to be warm. And in five minutes, there's going to be food. All right.

So remember that. Pisces, your attitudes, your values. Skip the crispy critter shit. Taurus, tap root, fourth place, grounding. Little problem. That's normally very solid. But Uranus has come through Taurus for the last seven years.



That's Uranus, it's about to, you can see the arrow, about to enter Gemini, but it's been in Taurus since 2018.

In late 2017, society started had a whole new inflammatory bout of problematic values. We'll leave out what that was about, peaking 2017-18. At the same time Chiron went into Ares this is this has been a particularly aggressive era, though we could say that, I have to say that that Donald, I wish somebody would replay this footage, Donald Trump rallies in 2016 where the one in Vermont Maine, where he's talking about throw the guy out of the cold and don't give him his coat.

What kind of crap is that? So this period of destabilization, and I think meanness, and I think this whole talk of putting the chips into the bodies, serious talk, and serious talk of artificial intelligence replacing the human capacity to reason, that's all Uranus and Taurus. That's about to end.

Uranus is going to go into Gemini. And that, that factors into our story because Gemini is really you're your creative zone. House five, place five, creative zone. Jupiter's been there, by the way. Jupiter's going into cancer. This'll be a good opportunity to take care of your health.

It'll be a good opportunity to improve your work space. And speaking of work space, you need a cozy work space. I know that aquarians, you might think the joke of Aquarius is that it rents an apartment and doesn't bother putting any furniture in or, oh, you don't, you forget to turn the gas on when the electric's on.

So you just boil a big pot of water on the stove. No problem. But the truth is that with the sign cancer on the house associated with the place of work and the style of working, you need that to be homey and cozy. Work at home works very well for Aquarius. You have the personal discipline to do it.

You have the work ethic to do it. Aquarius is naturally about boundaries. And we're all checking devices into the wee hours of the morning anyway. Might as well get something done, but you don't really need to go to work.

Let me revise that. The reason you would need to go into work. is to have some experience every week or so, a couple of days a week, one day a week, of being around other people. Very important for Aquarius. Very activating for Aquarius to be around other people. This whole side of your chart continues to be activated.

We see 3, all about ideation. House 5, that's creativity, but Gemini also is about ideation. Gemini is the third sign, there's a parallel third sign third house. Okay, so that's this, you've got some badass creative mojo happening right now, and I suggest that you take advantage of it. And in my critique of digital conditions, I am not here to shit talk the creative and loving use of digital technology, which is what we are doing right now.

The problem I have is the cutoff, is the digital haze. The trouble I have with is the acting as if we are phantoms in the physical plane. Digital consciousness is also very aggressive. The reason it is aggressive is it doesn't know who it is. And one of the reasons why you are very fortunate to have all of this activation of Aries in your third in your third place, is because it's going to keep reminding you of who you are.

And then your ideas are going to be ideas that are based on who you are. And you can go quite far with this. So Gemini activated, Cancer activated. It's really all very interesting and exciting. But I think that between this combination of Aquarius having Pluto in it and Aries having these two major events, two planetary sign changes, which each count as an event, plus the conjunction that counts as an event, that's three.

Then comes the conjunction of Chiron and Eris, that's four. We could break this down into four major events in Aries.

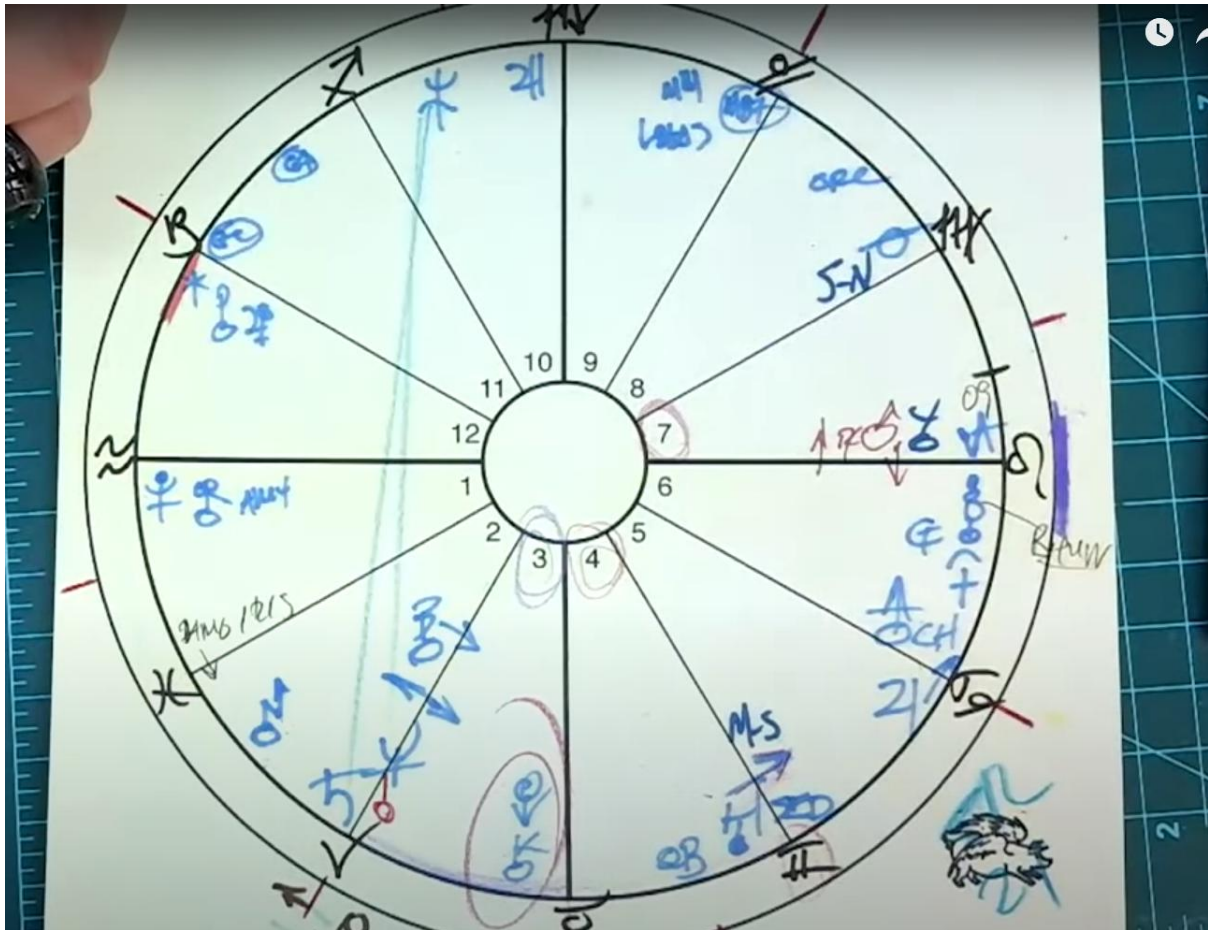
If you are struggling in any way, the thing to do is do some remembering of who you are, and remember that who you are needs to be grounded in your body, and that if you're going to let yourself temporarily forget who you are, which is always a good thing, that's not a digital phenomenon, that is a spiritual phenomenon, and digital is a metaphor of spiritual connection, but it's not the real thing. All you have to do is be alive. And probably not even that to be in contact with everything. But in terms of remembering who you are you thread the needle first through your body.

And you get yourself back into your body and you get yourself thinking from the inside out. And remember that all of this all this digital stuff, all this magical digital stuff, including me, presents you with a kind of a reflection.

Let's talk about the current Mars retrograde. Let's take a look at that and it'll be easier to see why it's so significant. 7th place is generally relationships, so too is the 8th, and by that one on one relationships and partnerships of the 7th become the financial and sexual relationships of the 8th.

You've got Leo here, and what's going on with Leo is that Mars is retrograde right here.



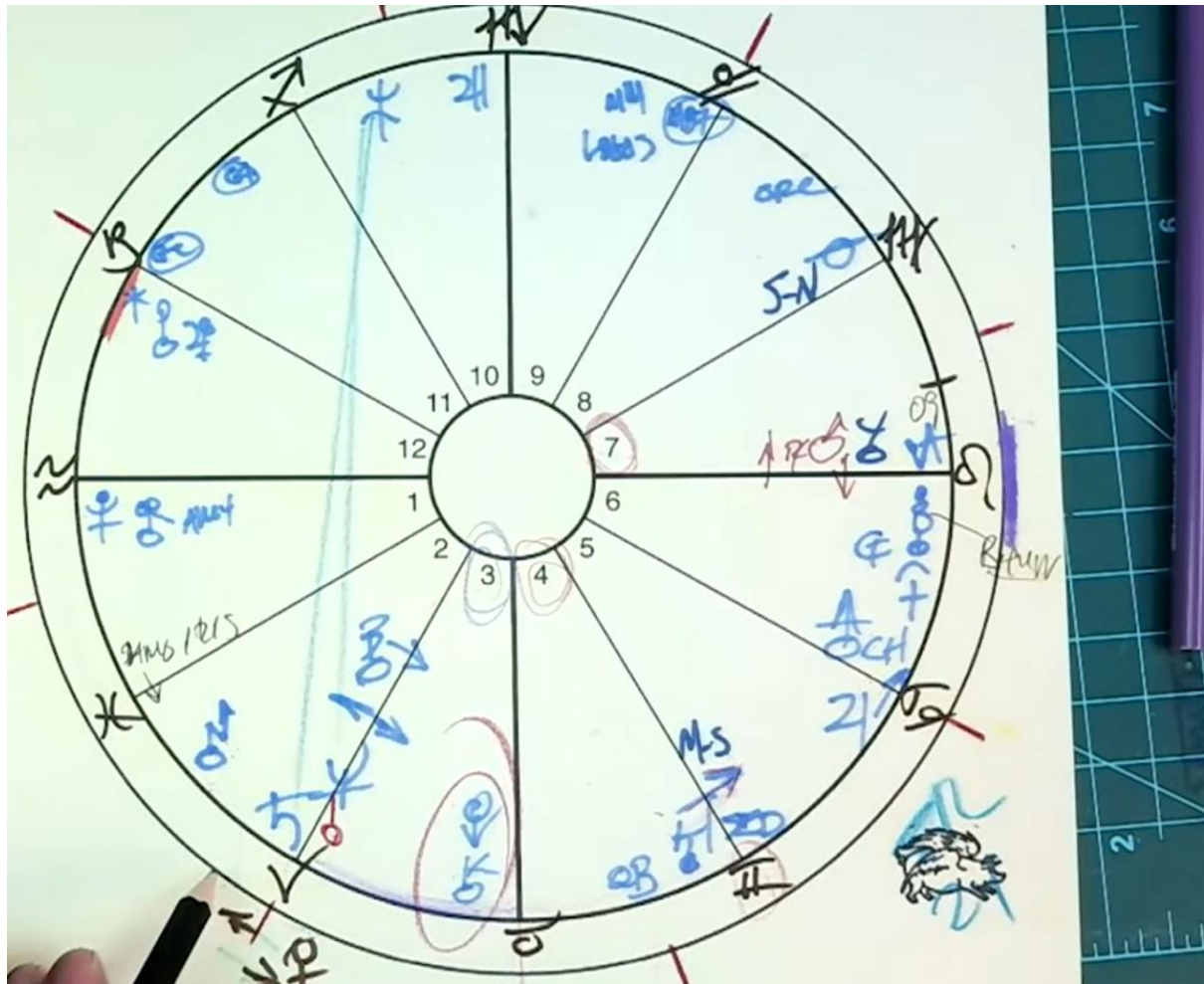
The Mars retrograde started here (purple line right side) conjunct a very powerful point.

That's right where the Mars retrograde started in Leo Back into cancer. There is some major reassessment of a relationship going on here. Don't give up on it, but on the other hand, I think the thing to ask yourself is what do you want to bring to the relationship? And what do your partners want to bring to the relationship and you first got to size this up yourself, you've got to assess this and then you've got to talk to your partner about it, assuming you have one.

What do you, what are you bringing to the relationship? What do you want from the relationship? That's it. And does relationship have a life and a purpose outside of the little society of me and you? I think relationships like dogs all need a job. So what is the job of your relationship? What is the thing that your relationship serves in the world.

And look, it could be dinner. If you have a relationship where you and your partner like to have dinner parties once a month or once a week, that's actually a very helpful contribution to the human race. What is the contribution of your

relationship to the human race? The other thing going on is there's this Venus retrograde now.



Venus is like about to enter Aries. And so this is a dance between your values and principles and how you express them. And Venus is going to go retrograde. It's going to make conjunctions to Saturn. It's already made them over the weekend, past weekend last weekend, January, first weekend, February, to Saturn and Neptune. It's going to come back. It's going to make them again. And it's going to be like a lot of conjunctions going on here.

And so, if you go back to the how you know what you know and keep it local that's what this is about. Venus though, running vanguard, going into Aries, then back into Pisces and back into Aries.

Saturn's gonna do that. Neptune's gonna do that. And Borasisi is doing that. Borasisi now solidly in Aries. What's Bor Sisi? I've got an article called "With love form Borasisi, Borasisi is about knowing the difference between

knowledge and belief. Very much the ideal thing to have for Aquarius in the third house.

The difference between knowledge and belief, which can be sussed out through a process of fact checking everything via “How do I know that? Why do I think that's true? Why do I believe that? Wow, I believe that. I don't know that. How do I know that?”

Okay, last thing. I think that the fundamental dynamic of Aquarius involves the relationship of the individual to the group. This is not that hard to figure out. It's not that hard to figure out when you have one bunch of definitions of Aquarius saying, Aquarius is a sign of groups. It's a sign of groups and organizations.

Okay, that's very nice. But it's also the sign of weirdos. It's a sign of people who are non-conformist. And so whenever someone is being non-conformist, you know that their Aquarius is doing its thing. The question is, are you? Really non-conformist? Or are you acting non-conformist? Are you conforming to the other non-conformists?

South Park has had great fun with that. Or are you actually standing in your own place and making up your own mind and you don't check yourself at the door when you enter a group situation. You don't defer the ethical crisis that you might have being part of group decision to the group.

You take the ethical burden on yourself. So that's in the dynamics of the individual and the group. Okay. So dynamic one is the group overpowers the individual. Dynamic two is the group does not overpower the individual, okay? Dynamic three is the individual changes the perception of the group. See the film Twelve Angry Men, okay?

That's not how people usually are. People are usually more like the Milgram experiment. Somebody tells them what to do. And there was another group experiment where, and if you know the name of this one, if you happen to have some psychology training and you know the name of this one please tell me.

It was one of those things where there's a group of people in the room and one, and the person who's the subject of the experiment doesn't know that the other people in the room are the Confederates of the researchers. They're part of the research team. And in this experiment, the leader of the group, who's of course in cahoots with everybody in the room, except for you, the person being experimented on would say “How many dots are on the page”?



And somebody would look at it and say, “Oh, there's four dots”. The next person would look at it and say, “there's four dots”. And then you'd get it and say...

“Four dots?” Why did you say that? Because the other two people said four dots. And maybe they're right. No, maybe, most people, check themselves at the door of a group situation. So you can't check yourself at the door of your group situations. And you will learn this easy way.

Or you'll learn this the motherfucking hard way.

Because they're going to say, ooh, Pluto's an Aquarius, time for central bank digital currency connected to your vaccine ID. What's a vaccine? Oh, a vaccine is just this chemical we inject into your body. We tell you, you're making a selfie. Trust us, we're the government. There's going to be some very important situations where you're going to have to think for yourself, no matter how many dots anybody says are on the page, no matter how intense the group dynamic is.

And it is very unlikely that you can change the group, you're not going to convince your whole family that they're wrong. You're lucky if you get one person who cares what you think about anything.

But you have to be the person who cares what you think. And if you have any people for whom you have. Some form of care or custody. You gotta care for them too. All right. I think I think that is that is it for today.

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
